Our GP, Nursing Team or Care Co-Ordinator are able to also refer you to our **Social Prescriber** who is able to help with social issues and are employed by Kirklees. Please note they will not be able to deal with medical related illnesses.

First Contact Physiotherapy

Our helpful receptionist are now able to book you an appointment directly with the Physiotherapist (FCP) they are able to deal with: All soft tissue injuries, sprains, strains or sports injuries, Arthritis, possible problems with muscles, ligaments, tendons or bone e.g. tennis elbow, carpal

tunnel syndrome and ankle sprain. Spinal pain including lower back pain, mid and neck pain. Spinal related pain in arms and legs including nerve symptoms e.g. pins and needles and post orthopaedic surgery.

Exclusions: Acutely unwell, children under 16, medical management of rheumatoid conditions, housebound patients.

There's no limit on the number of HRT prescription items you can get with it while it's valid. You'll save money if you're going to buy more than 2 prescription items in 12 months. How to buy
