Our Services - Adults

We offer free and confidential support to Adults in Kirklees who are using drugs or alcohol. This includes a range of treatment, recovery and support services to reduce use or stop completely.

We also support family members and concerned others affected by a loved one's drug or alcohol use.

We provide support for a full range of substances including illicit drugs, prescribed medications and Alcohol.

We can also support GP's with training, advice on prescribing and reductions/detox

We can support our service users with Gambling needs, offer smoking cessation and employment support.

We work closely with our Young Persons Service – The Base.
